Its 1,662 citations are divided into six sections: academic libraries as a whole, administrators and administrative concerns, access services, technical services, and the future and role of academic libraries and librarians. Author, article title, book/journal title, and subject indexes provide access to related citations throughout the work. Obviously, such bibliographies become dated very quickly, but this one is invaluable, serving as a handy, single-volume guide to recent literature.
