

He is the author of Britain, Japan and Pearl Harbor: Avoiding War in East Asia 1936-41 (1995) and British Intelligence and the Japanese Challenge in Asia, 1914-1941 (2002) and a number of scholarly articles on Anglo-Japanese relations in the inter-war period.

Jussi M. Hanhimaki is Professor of International History and Politics at the Graduate Institute of International Studies, Geneva, Switzerland and an editor of Cold War History. He is the author of Understanding the Cold War: A History in Documents and Eyewitness Accounts (2003), with Arne Westad, An Insecure Friendship: the United States and Scandinavia Since 1945 (1997), Containing Coexistence: America, Russia, and the `Finnish Solution' 1945-1956 (1997) and Rinnakkaiseloa patoamassa: Yhdysvallat ja Paasikiven linja, 1948-1956 (1996).

Joseph A. Maiolo is Lecturer in International History in the Department of War Studies at King's College London. He is author of The Royal Navy and Nazi Germany: A Study in Appeasement and the Origins of the Second World War (1998), editor, with Robert Boyce, of The Origins of World War Two: The Debate Continues (2003), and Assistant Editor of The Journal of Strategic Studies. He is currently working on a study of the global arms race and the origins of the Second World War.

Kirsten E. Schulze is Senior Lecturer in International History at the London School of Economics. She is the author of Israel's Covert Diplomacy in Lebanon (1998), The Arab-Israeli Conflict (1999), The Jews of Lebanon: Between Conflict and Coexistence (2001) and the co-editor of Nationalisms, Minorities and Diasporas: Identities and Rights and the Middle East (1996). She has also published numerous articles on conflict, negotiations and reform in the Middle East, Northern Ireland, and Indonesia.
